As we move through **Week 8 of Term 1**, our school continues to be filled with energy, pride and a wonderful sense of community. One of the highlights of the past few weeks has been the commencement of our **school tours for prospective 2027 Foundation families**. It has been an absolute pleasure showing future families through our classrooms and learning spaces. The feedback we have received has been incredibly positive, with many visitors commenting on how engaged our students are in their learning, how polite and respectful they are, and how neat and organised the school environment is. One priceless comment that truly captured the spirit of our school was that *Westmeadows Primary has such a beautiful vibe from staff, students and parents*. I couldn't agree more — **go Team Westy!**

Tonight, we will also hold the first meeting of our **new School Council**. During this meeting we will elect our office bearers and complete the annual Child Safe training. I would like to extend a sincere thank you to the parents and staff who generously volunteer their time to serve on School Council and support the governance and strategic direction of our school. Your contribution is greatly valued. I will communicate the newly elected **President, Treasurer and Secretary** positions with the community via COMPASS once they have been confirmed. You may also have heard about the current **industrial action** taking place across Victorian government schools. As part of this, a **stop work action has been planned for Tuesday 24 March 2026**. The school will continue to follow the advice and timelines provided by the Department of Education. Families will be notified via COMPASS by **2:00pm on Monday 23 March** regarding the school's capacity to supervise students on the day.

A huge congratulations to our **Grade 3 and Grade 5 students** who have recently completed their **NAPLAN assessments**. We have been incredibly impressed by the focus, resilience and persistence shown by our students throughout the testing period. They should all feel very proud of the way they approached the challenge.

Our **Glasses for Kids** program was also highly successful this year. Around **10% of our Foundation to Grade 3 students who attended appointments received free glasses**, which will make a significant difference to their learning and wellbeing. We are hopeful the program will return next year, and I strongly encourage families to provide consent when the opportunity arises.

It has also been fantastic to see **so many parents attending our Friday assemblies**. Each week we welcome over 500 people into our gym, and I could not be prouder of our School Leaders — **Indi, Degan, Audrey and Tait** — who confidently lead these assemblies and represent our school so well. Recently we also heard an excellent presentation from our **Grade 4 students** about **staying safe online**, an important reminder that digital safety should remain front and centre in our homes as well as at school. It was also wonderful to hear the positive and thoughtful messages shared by **Sophia and Ema from 3L** about what makes our school such a special place.

The school continues to buzz with activity, learning and celebration, and I am very much looking forward to seeing our students participate in **Harmony Day this Friday** as we celebrate the diversity, inclusion, and sense of belonging that makes our community so special.

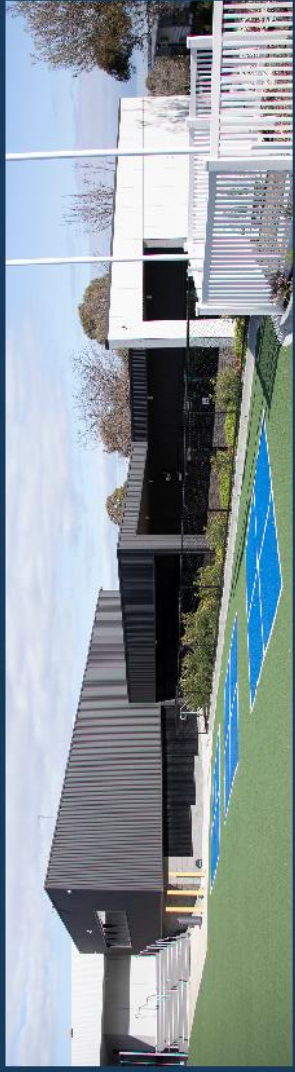

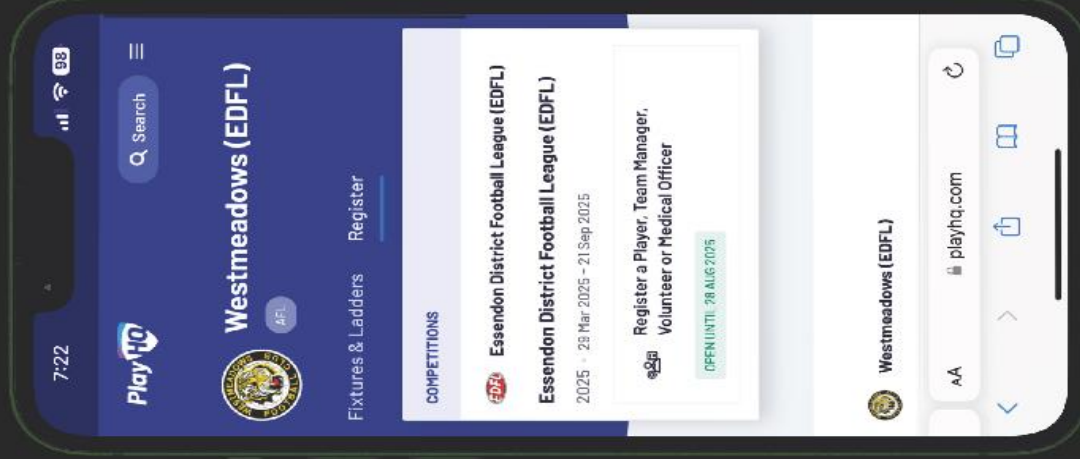
