For iPhone and iPad Users:



1. Click the "App Store" icon on your Apple device.
2. Type Westmeadows in the search.
3. You will see Westmeadows appear, click "Get" then "Install".
4. The app is FREE to download.
5. When installed click "Open"
6. Select "OK" to receive push notifications, when asked.
7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.

For Android Users:



You must first have signed up with a Google Account before installing the app.

1. Click the "Play Store" button on your Android Device
2. Click the magnifying glass icon at the top and type in Westmeadows
3. Click the school name when it appears in the search.
4. Click the "Install" button.
5. Click "Accept" for various permissions (please note, we do not modify any of your personal data on your device).
6. Click "Open" when installed.
7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.

Please Note: Some brands of Android phones need the setting in "Notification Manager" changed to "Allow" instead of "Notify" in order for the push notifications to work. The phone must also be running at least version 4 system software to run the app.

For Windows 8.1 Phones and Windows 8.1 or 10 Device Users:



1. Go to the Windows Store on your 8.1 Windows Phone or Windows 8.1/10 Device
2. Search for "Skoolbag" in the keyword app search
3. Install the Skoolbag app
4. Find Westmeadows either by using the keyword search or location service.
5. Click the "Pin" icon to pin the school tile to your Windows Phone home screen.
6. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup"
7. Toggle the Push Categories that are applicable to you by tapping the on/off switch.

Junior School Council is proudly supporting the call to recycle old mobile phones in collaboration with one of our Grandparents.

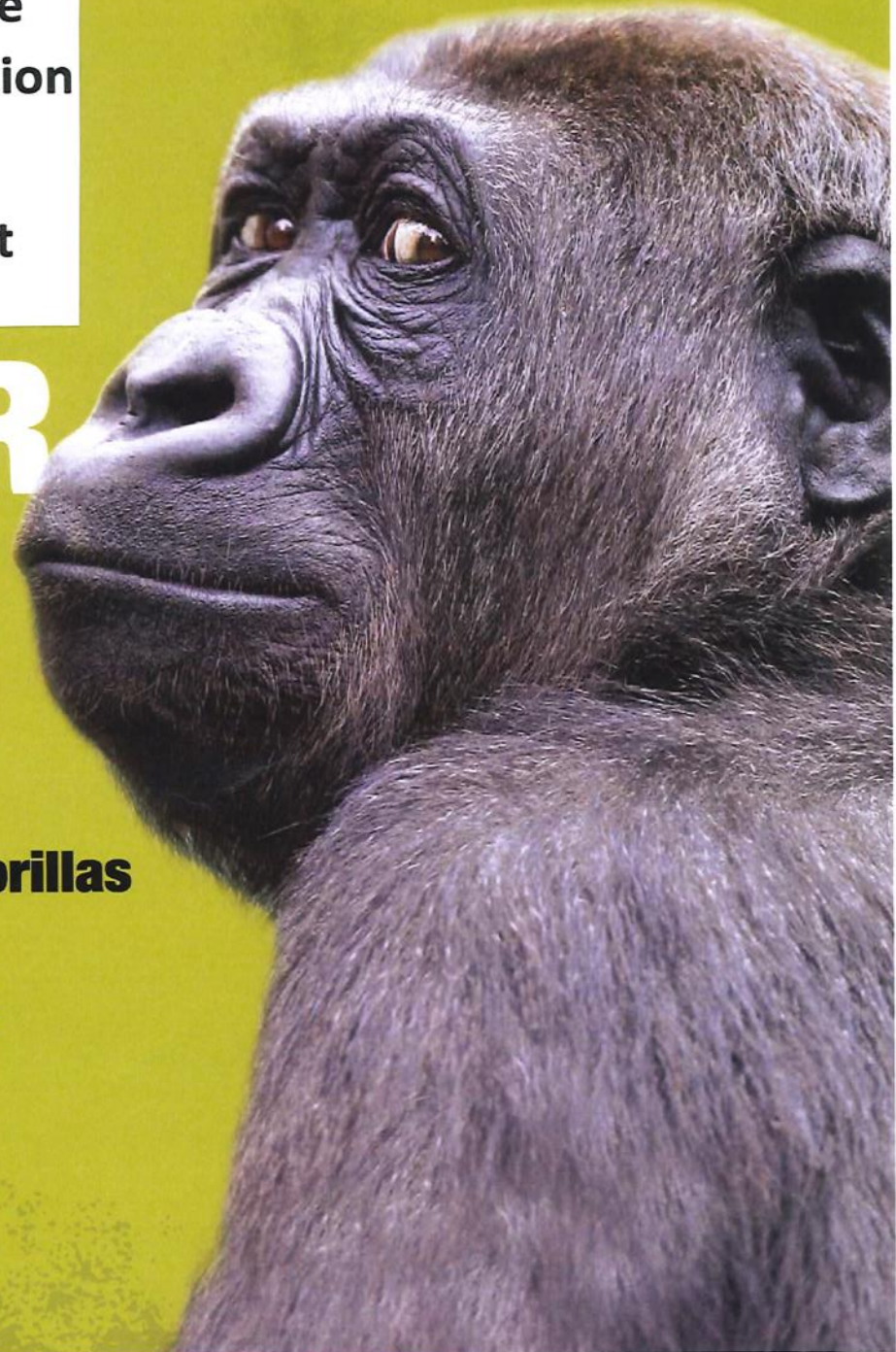

HOW YOU'RE HELPING GORILLAS

Your mobile phone may contain a mineral called coltan. Coltan is mined in locations including critical habitat for Eastern Lowland Gorillas in Central Africa. The threats gorillas face as a result of mining include:

- + Deforestation - Mining leads to habitat loss and habitat fragmentation, reducing areas where gorillas can survive.
- + As a result of habitat loss, gorillas come into contact more frequently with humans, increasing likelihood of competition for space or resources.
- + Disease - With increased human activity, gorillas have increased exposure to human illnesses, such as the flu, some of which can be fatal.

When you recycle your phones there are a number of environmental benefits:

- + Your phone will be saved from landfill, with some or all components able to be recycled or re-used.
- + By recycling through this program, you also raise important funds for gorilla conservation. This program supports the Gorilla Doctors, which helps treat ill and injured gorillas in Africa.

What to Bring

✓ Food

- A healthy morning tea and lunch such as fruits, wholemeal sandwiches and dips. For lunchbox ideas visit <http://heas.health.vic.gov.au/schools/healthy-lunchboxes>. Please do not include items which need to be reheated.
- Due to the risk of anaphylaxis items containing nuts should not be included in the lunchbox.
- Breakfast and afternoon tea will be provided.

✓ A drink bottle

- Water will be available all day to refill the bottles.

✓ Hat

- A SunSmart hat similar to the one worn at school.
- Sunscreen will be provided throughout the day.

✓ Appropriate clothing

- Clothing suitable for an active day, including closed toe shoes and a jacket if it is predicted to be wet or cold.

✓ Medication

- Medication and Management/Action Plans if required.

✗ Devices

- We encourage children to be active and engage with their peers so personal electronic devices such as phones, iPads, laptops and game consoles should be left at home.
- These devices will remain the families responsibly through the session, including for any loss or damage.

Medical Management plans

If your child has been diagnosed with a medical condition, we are required under the Education & Care regulations to have a completed medical action/management plan, along with any medication which may be required available at the service at all times during your child's attendance.

Blank copies of the medical plans can be accessed through your medical practitioner or from the TheirCare service.

In the interests of the child's safety, care may be refused on the day should the appropriate documentation or medication not be supplied or is incomplete.

Changes to programming

Activities and times are subject change due to unforeseen circumstances such as severe weather and provider availability. In the rare event that an activity will unable to be run, an alternative activity will be provided and will be communicate the change via email/SMS to all families who are effected and will be updated on the website.

Changes to your booking

We understand that your needs may change in the lead up to your attendance at the Holiday Program. Whether you need to add an additional day to keep the kids busy or cancel a day to suit your schedule, we're there for you.

Simply log into your Fully Booked account anytime to make the relevant changes or give us a call on 1300 072 410 between 8:30 am to 6:00 pm on weekdays.

As we plan our programming, suppliers and educators in advance to the day to ensure that the children have lots of fun. Any changes made within the 5 days of booking will incur a \$10.00 charge.

When making additional bookings, the \$10.00 is eligible for the Child Care Subsidy, which means you may only need to pay the gap, depending on your families' circumstances.
