Good afternoon all,

I can hardly believe this is the final newsletter for Term 1. Where has the time flown to? I am certainly very proud of the dedication my staff show every day towards their allocated roles and responsibilities. Most exciting though is the work that is being done in every lesson of every day, in every classroom. ## Student Attendance

This week we have been alerted to the children who have concerns regarding their attendance. Please remember the days that children have away from school may have a negative impact on the child. Holidays, illness, shopping during school hours, appointments etc all contribute to your child's absences. The 'best rule of thumb' is to only allow your child to be absent if they are sick/ill. Holidays should be planned for school holidays and vacation breaks. Where possible medical appointments should be made for out of school
