# Ms. D's Diary 

## Good afternoon all,

## Student Attendance

This week we have been alerted to the children who have concerns regarding their attendance. Please remember the days that children have away from school may have a negative impact on the child. Holidays, illness, shopping during school hours, appointments etc all contribute to your child's absences.
The 'best rule of thumb' is to only allow your child to be absent if they are sick/ill. Holidays should be planned for school holidays and vacation breaks. Where possible medical appointments should be made for out of school hours.
We are aiming for children to have no more than eight days absence in any given year for illness.
