Celebration Week is a tradition all students, teachers and school community members look forward to and it is one we show with great pride. From Foundation to Grade Six, students compose their own picture story book that they keep as a memento each year. Each student is encouraged to express their individuality and creativity through their words and illustrations. This year our Celebration Week will include:

- -Big Dreams Performance: Perform Education are kicking off our Celebration Week with a performance for Foundation-Grade 2, and Grade 3-6 all about persisting to overcome obstacles and achieve a dream.


Our school will appear in 'Nearby Locations' if you're within 10kms of the school, or search for our school by name.

When first accessing our school you will be prompted to add a student profile for your child. This allows you to make orders and payments for them. If you have made a purchase you can select our school from 'Previous Location'





For iPhone and iPad Users:



- 1. Click the "App Store" icon on your Apple device.
- 2. Type Westmeadows in the search.
- You will see Westmeadows appear, click "Get" then "Install".
- 4. The app is FREE to download.
- 5. When installed click "Open"
- 6. Select "OK" to receive push notifications, when asked.
- Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
- Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.

For Android Users:



You must first have signed up with a Google Account before installing the app.

- 1. Click the "Play Store" button on your Android Device
- Click the magnifying glass icon at the top and type in <u>Westmeadows</u>
- 3. Click the school name when it appears in the search.
- 4. Click the "Install" button.
- Click "Accept" for various permissions (please note, we do not modify any of your personal data on your device).
- 6. Click "Open" when installed.
- Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
- Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.

Please Note: Some brands of Android phones need the setting in "Notification Manager" changed to "Allow" instead of "Notify" in order for the push notifications to work. The phone must also be running at least version 4 system software to run the app.

For Windows 8.1 Phones and Windows 8.1 or 10 Device Users:

- Go to the Windows Store on your 8.1 Windows Phone or Windows 8.1/10 Device
- 2. Search for "Skoolbag" in the keyword app search
- 3. Install the Skoolbag app
- Find <u>Westmeadows</u> either by using the keyword search or location service.
- Click the "Pin" icon to pin the school tile to your Windows Phone home screen.
- Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup"
- Toggle the Push Categories that are applicable to you by tapping the on/off switch.

Please Note: The Skoolbag Windows App is for $8.1\ version$ Windows Phones, or Windows $8.1\ and\ 10\ devices$.
