The major news for Westmeadows Primary School this week is that we were required to merge one of four Grade One classes into three Grade One classes. We needed to make this move due to the immediate resignation of Ms Emma Hajnal our Grade $1 G$ teacher.
This action was taken in the best interests of the children, to have them quickly settled with minimal disruption to their learning and social connections. The whole teaching team swung into gear to ready the classrooms for the additional children. We will employ additional Education Support staff to support the classes.

I would like to thank all the Grade 1 parents and carers, particularly those who have children in 1G, for their complete understanding and support. Unfortunately, during these times with mass teacher shortages we only had the one option. I am so pleased to report that the new classes started today and have enjoyed a great start.
