#### **Our Classrooms**

I am really pleased to report that the learning in our classrooms is going full steam ahead with staff implementing lessons based on the Science of Learning. We are seeing a different level of engagement from most of our students as they have to prove their understanding every step of the way to their teachers and peers. Sadly, we are still seeing maybe one or two children not applying their best effort during learning times. This plays out in distracting others or not completing their work. Next week each child will be receiving a Social Emotional report which details your child's work and behaviours. If there is something on that report that you haven't already spoken to your child's teacher about, please make an appointment for a meeting to discuss a plan for improving your child's behaviour.

#### **GRIP Student Leadership Conference**

Our Student Leaders had the privilege of attending the GRIP Leadership Conference. By all reports the day was super engaging and gave our students loads of ideas about how they can build their leadership capacity now and in the future.

I would like to thank our School Captains and Vice captains and our Student Voicer Agents for attending the excursion and representing Westmeadows Primary School in such a positive way.

#### Attendance

Just a reminder that the Department of Education expect all children to be at school every available school day except for medical illnesses or medical appointments that cannot be scheduled after hours. Parents are strongly encouraged to book holidays during the term breaks. Where this is not possible, parents/carers must meet with the child's teacher to develop an Absence Plan. It is then the Principal's responsibility to either approve or not approve the absence based on a student's current attendance data.
